The facilities covered hereby shall be installed in accordance with the attached plan and subject to the County's specifications. Company will be responsible for any road or ROW damage resulting from their construction for one year after installation of facility. Also, the County will not be held responsible for any future damage to facilities along this route if proper notification of road improvement is reported to utility representative.

In order to eliminate potential damage to existing road surfaces or ROWs please refrain from doing work during or immediately after inclement weather. Permittee will be responsible for any damage to the ROW and/or the removal of dirt and debris carried onto the roadway.

During the initial installation or construction of facilities authorized by this permit, or during any future repair, removal, or relocation, the permittee shall, at all times, maintain flagmen, signs, lights, flares, barricades, and other safety devices in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and as may be necessary to properly protect traffic upon the highway and to warn and safeguard the public against injury or damage.

Permittee shall give the County a minimum of 24 hours notice prior to beginning any work under this permit.

The approval of this application and the granting of a permit to perform the described work shall be in accordance with the plans and provisions hereof. This permit shall be strictly construed, and no work, other than that specifically described above, is authorized. Subsequent normal maintenance expected.
