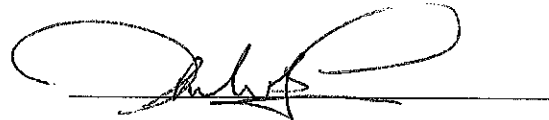
1. **CALL TO ORDER.** Vice Chairman Towles called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.
2. **MINUTES.** The motion to approve the minutes from the special called June 23, 2026 Special Called Board of Elections Meeting to Certify the June 16th Runoff Election Results was made by Board Member Pierce. Vice Chairman Towles seconded the motion. The minutes from the June 23, 2026 Special Called Board of Elections Meeting to Certify the June 16th Runoff Election were unanimously approved as presented.
3. **ACTION ITEMS.**
Vice Chairman Towles opened the Public Hearing to relocate the Ellerslie Precinct from Cornerstone Baptist Church to the Ellerslie Park Lodge at 5:11 p.m. No one registered to address the Board during the Public Hearing period. There no being one registered to speak, Vice Chairman Towles closed the Public Hearing at 5:12 p.m.

There was general discussion on the relocation, which Supervisor Bryce restated for public record purposes was due to ongoing construction on the Cornerstone campus.

There being no further discussion, Vice Chairman Towles made a motion to approve the relocation of the Ellerslie Precinct from Cornerstone Baptist Church to the Ellerslie Park Lodge. Board Member Pierce second the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

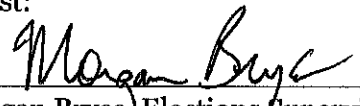
4. **BOARD/STAFF REPORTS.**

There was general discussion on the state of the Elections Office and its overall preparedness for the upcoming election.

Vice Chairman Towles requested Supervisor Bryce to purchase some items to help better display Election Night Results in the entrance to the Harris County Elections Office, and Supervisor Bryce stated that he would review and purchase some items before his departure.
5. **ADJOURNMENT.** There being no further business to discuss, the motion to adjourn was made by Vice Chairman Towles, seconded by Board Member Pierce, and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 1:25 p.m.
